## Activity holidays 1 Snowshoeing in the French Alps

You can tuck into guilt-free meals of fondue and red wine when you've been snowshoeing all day. On this eight-day holiday based in the village of Samoëns in Haute-Savoie, guests will reach the top of several summits, including Pointe Ratti, Le Parteset and Tête de la Sallaz, with great views of Mont Blanc. If it all sounds a bit daunting, the organisers say it's suitable for enthusiastic novices too.

## 2 Walk in Bavaria

Get into the winter spirit on a walking holiday in Bavaria.

Amble though wintery forests on snowy paths by day and spend evenings in Füssen, a small town in the shadow of Neuschwanstein, one of several fairytale castles you'll see on this trip. And there's plenty of time for warming Bavarian meals and a beer or two along the way.

### 3 Family Finland
